

Monaco Service Maintenance Menu

For engine, transmission and generator services please refer to our flyers.

- Refer Service** ~ Clean burn assembly & orifice. Clean out chimney. Check plumbing for LP & water leaks. Test heating element. Test unit operation.
- LP Furnace** ~ Remove furnace, clean burn assembly & orifice. Clean heat exchanger & chimney. Install furnace, check for LP leaks. Test unit operation.
- LP/AC Water Heater** ~ Clean burn tube & orifice. Clean heat exchanger and chimney. Drain tank and replace anode rod (if applicable). Test heating element. Inspect ECO & Thermostat. Check for LP leaks. Test unit operation.
- Aqua-Hot, Hydro-Hot, Hurricane** ~ Check fluid levels, inspect all hoses & fittings, change fuel nozzle & filter, align igniter, clean & inspect burn chamber. Test system.
- Roof A/C** ~ Clean return air circulation filter, clean air box housing & control panel, clean & degrease evaporator coil, clean & degrease condenser, clear condensation drains, inspect mounting bolt and foam gaskets.
- Roof Seals** ~
 - Inspect condition of roof seam and component seals. Spot seal where necessary.
 - Peel sealant off of all components on roof and re-seal. Water test for leaks.
- Batteries** ~ Unit should sit without charge or draw on batteries for 20 minutes. Check batteries with Hydrometer. Remove batteries. Clean & lube trays. Inspect cables & cable terminals. Install batteries & top off fluids. ***Battery replacement packages are also available. Please ask your service advisor for details on your coach.***
- Brake Inspection** ~ Remove wheels & drums, visually inspect friction surfaces. Check slack adjusters & hardware. Visually inspect brake lines from standoff to hub.
- Air Dryer** ~
 - Remove air dryer assembly, over haul with kit, inspect lines & fittings. Check operation of system.
 - Remove & replace air dryer assembly with new. Inspect lines & fittings. Check operation of system.
- Chassis Lube** ~
 - Lube front steering components (including steering shaft inside coach). Lube drive shaft.
 - Full chassis lube above and front & rear brake systems.
- Alignment** ~ Perform visual inspection of chassis & suspension components (bushings, tie-rod ends, shocks) and tires. Perform 4 or 6 (tag axle coaches) wheel geometry inspection and adjust as necessary.
