

PRE-TRAVEL INSPECTION

- Check Tire Pressure on RV - Inflate/Deflate to Proper PSI (See Manufacturer Specs as Necessary)
- Inspect RV Tires for Abnormal Wear or Damage
- Lock All Storage Bay Doors
- Clean Windshield
- Clean Side Mirrors
- Check Windshield Wiper Blades for Damage

HOOK UP TOW VEHICLE

- Install Tow Bar Into RV Hitch Receiver
- Connect Vehicle to Tow Bar
- Connect Safety Cables/Chains
- Connect Emergency Breakaway Cable
- Connect 7-Pin Light Cable To RV and Tow Vehicle
- Light Check (Running Lights, Brake Lights, L/R Signals, Hazards)
- Check Bike Rack that Bikes are Properly Secured in Tow Vehicle Hitch Receiver

INSIDE YOUR COACH

KITCHEN

- Clear Kitchen Counter
- Add Tension Bar to Refrigerator Shelves to Secure Items
- Lock Refrigerator
- Drop Dinette Table if Car Seats are Needed
- Prepare Seat-Belts for all Passengers
- Strap in Car Seats
- Fill Water Bottles

BATHROOM

- Secure Loose Items
- Remove and Secure Loose Shower Bottles
- Lock Shower Doors in Place

OVERALL

- Pick Up and Stow Rugs
- Sweep
- Check Surrounding Area of Slideout Before Sliding in
- Close all Windows
- Bring in Slides

OUTSIDE YOUR COACH

UTILITIES

- Disconnect Utility Hookups
- Drain Black Tank
- Rinse Black Tank (10 Mins)
- Stow Rinse Hose
- Drain Gray Tank
- Disconnect and Stow Sewer Hose
- Turn Off Freshwater Faucet
- Disconnect and Stow Fresh Water Hose
- Switch RV Water Selector to "Dry Camping"
- Turn Off Power Breaker
- Disconnect, Stow Surge Protector, and Power Cord

PACK UP CAMPSITE

- Sweep Off Mat
- Fold and Stow Mat
- Fold and Stow Chairs
- Stow Kids Toys
- Clean and Breakdown Griddle/Grill
- Stow Griddle/Grill
- Bring in Awning
- Collapse and Stow any Tents or Clamps
- Spray Lube on Leveler Shafts
